School News & Updates

Safeguarding

I understand that at times parents need to speak to their child's class teacher, however could I please ask that you do not approach the teacher at the beginning or end of the school day when they are admitting or dismissing the class. At this time, the teachers need to ensure that all children are handed over safely to their parents/carers. Messages can be passed on to the teacher by calling or emailing the office. If you do need to speak to the teacher, please contact the office to make an appointment. Thank you for your understanding. A gentle reminder that in the morning parents should drop children at the school gates, they should not be in the playground. Again, this is important to ensure the safeguarding of all children.

Dogs in the Playground.

Just a reminder that it is West Lothian Council Policy that dogs should not be brought into the school playground at any time.

Absences/Lates

If your child is ill or unable to come to school, please contact the school before 9.30am. If we have no communication on the reason your child is absent, we will commence our Safe Arrivals Procedure.

Unfortunately, the high number of children being late in our school continues to have a negative impact on children, how they settle in the morning as well as how they are accessing their learning. As previously stated, every class teacher has learning set up from 8.55am. The minute the children are in class, they are engaged in a range of learning. From 8.55am, our pupil support team also start their targeted interventions to work on spelling, reading and numeracy skills. If your child is late, they are missing out on all of this. The impact this has on the operational parts of the school is also huge, kitchen staff need numbers for school dinners at 9.15am so they can cook and prepare for the day and Mrs Fowley has safe arrivals checks to complete by 9:30am. When children arrive after this time, it also putting them under significant pressure. As always, if you wish to discuss your child's lateness or feel we can support in any way, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Snacks/Water

We encourage children to bring a **small healthy snack** each day to have during our morning break. This is a short break and children do not have long to eat more than one snack. We also encourage all children to bring a reusable water bottle to school each day filled with **water**. In line with guidance we ask that only water is brought to drink throughout the day.

Wider Achievements

At Deans Primary School we want to celebrate all achievements both in and out of school. If your child has an achievement out with school that they would like to celebrate we would love to hear all about it. If they have received a certificate, medal or have a photo of their achievement, they can bring this to school on Fridays and we will share it at assembly.

Safe Parking

When dropping off or picking up can I please ask you to be considerate of other road users and pedestrians. I understand it can become very busy, however the safety of our children is of the utmost importance. The school car park should not be used to drop off or pick up children, this car park is for staff and visitors only. Please also avoid walking through the car park, please use the path.

School Fund

Thank you to everyone who has donated to school fund for dress down days and throughout the session so far. Our school fund is used to directly benefit the children in our school e.g. subsidising school trips, paying for school events and activities etc.

School Uniform



We are very proud of our school uniform at Deans Primary School. We ask that all pupils wear their uniform every day. If you do need access to school uniform there is a supply of items available at the Sharing Shed or from the school, please ask.

If your child does not wish to change for PE, they should come dressed in joggers or leggings and a polo or T-Shirt, with their school jumper over it. It is West Lothian Council policy that ***NO FOOTBALL STRIPS*** should be worn to school.

We would also ask as the winter approaches that all children have a **change of shoes that they can wear inside.**

We are still amassing lost property! Please name all your child's belongings so items can be easily returned should anything be found/handed in from around the school.

Literacy

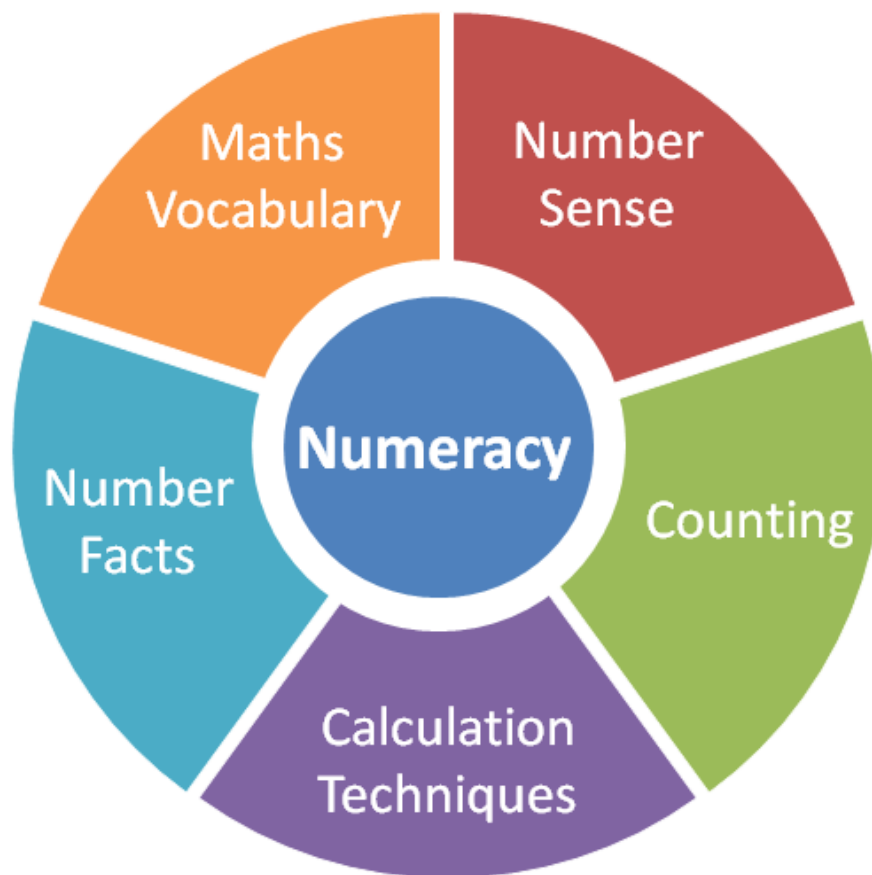


In reading we will be concentrating on Prosody and Fluency as well as developing our skills in Clarifying, Summarising and Questioning.

It is very important that you register for these benefits if you are entitled to them.

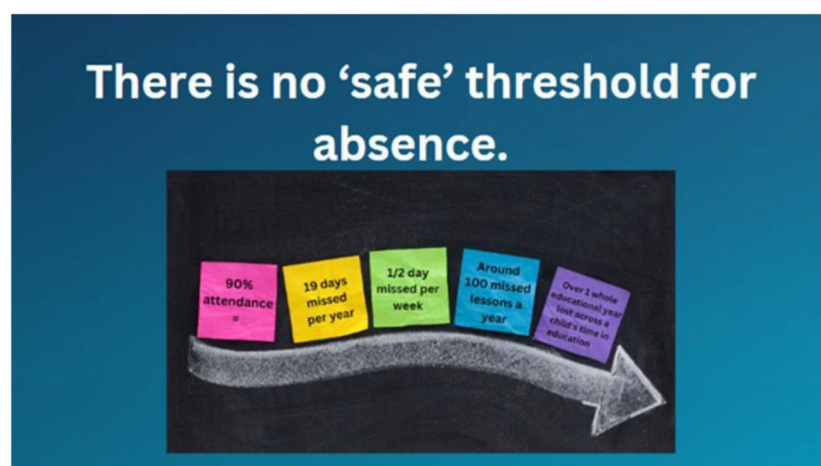
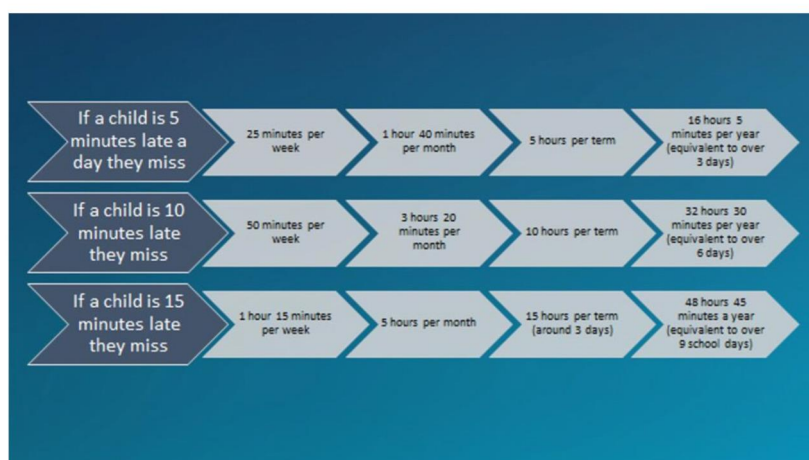
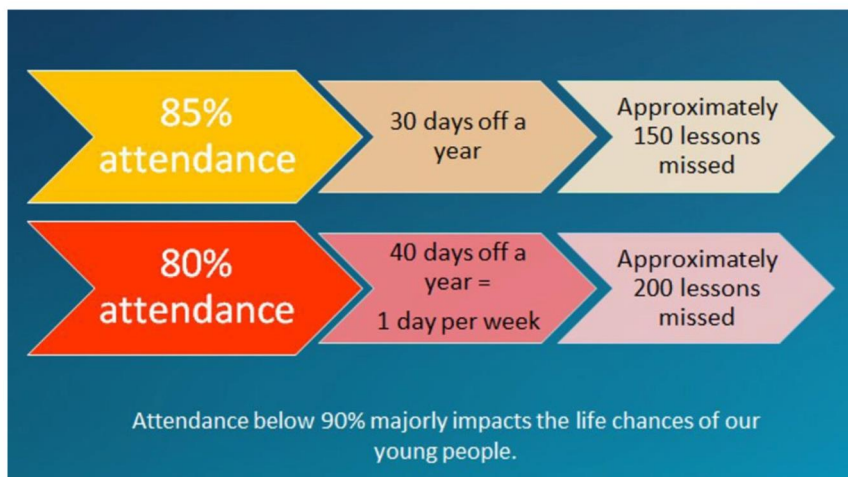
Attendance



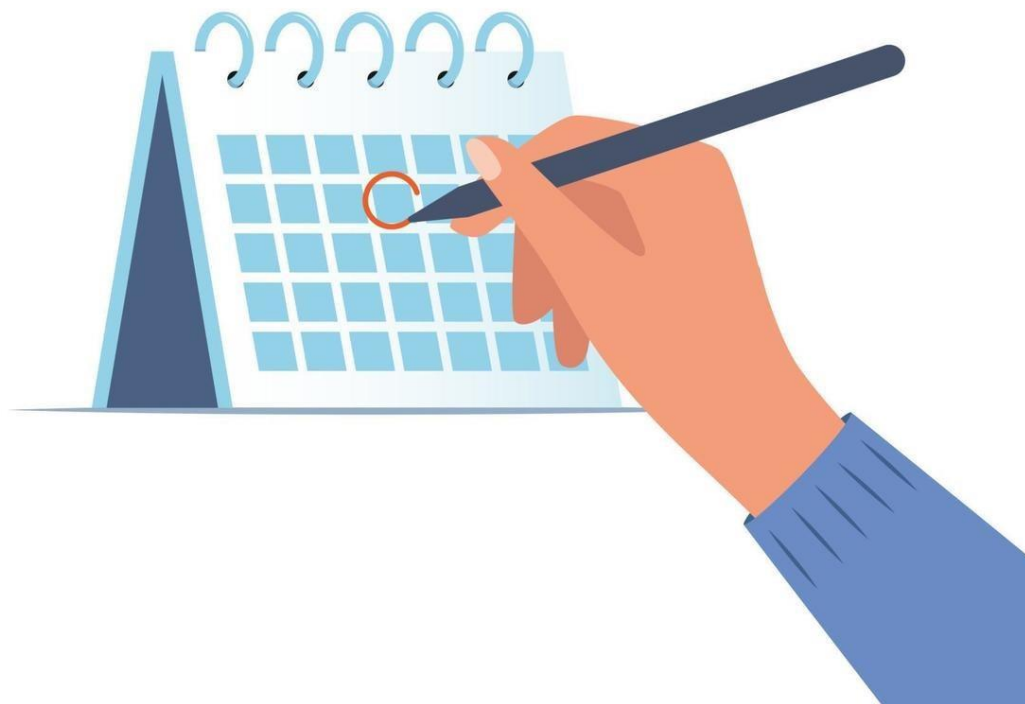
