Safety Reminder	Could we remind parents not to open the nursery door to let anyone into the cloakroom. This is a safety measure to allow us to know exactly who is coming into the building. IF you need to speak with a member of the team at drop-off or pickup could be ask that this not be the person on the door as it can distract from the safety procedures we have in place.
